



Privacy Policy

Buff Clothing Ltd processes personal data in relation to its employees, suppliers and customers. It is vitally important that we abide by the principles of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) set out below. This privacy policy explains what personal information we may collect about you, how we may use it and what we do to keep it secure, it will also outline what rights you have regarding your personal information and how to contact us should this become necessary.

Processing means obtaining, recording or holding the data, it includes organising, adapting and amending the data.

By engaging Buff Clothing Ltd to provide garment designs samples and products to your organisation you consent to us processing any personal details provided in order for us to fulfil our contractual and legal obligations. If we intend to use your data for any other purpose, we must obtain your specific consent.

Gathering Information:

Any details that you may submit to us via this website or during subsequent discussions or transactions will be stored by us and will be accessible by employees of the company or third parties who are involved in the production process. GDPR requires Buff Clothing Ltd as data controller to process data in accordance with the principles of data protection.

The requirements state that data shall be:

1. Fairly and lawfully processed
 2. Processed for limited purposes
 3. Adequate, relevant and not excessive
 4. Accurate
 5. Not kept longer than reasonably necessary
 6. Processed in accordance with the data subject's rights
 7. Kept securely
 8. Not transferred to countries outside the European Economic Area without adequate protection.
- We process this personal data as necessary to aid the design and production process. We are required by law to hold your information for as long as is necessary to comply with our statutory and contractual obligations and in accordance with our legitimate interests as a data controller. We will take reasonable action to ensure that your Personal Data is maintained and up to date.
 - You have the right to request a copy of the information we hold for you on our systems and the right to be deleted from our databases. Please email us if you would like to submit a request of this kind.
 - We may collect personal information about you from our website, from telephone calls, emails, meetings and other written and verbal communications. We would usually expect to keep a record of your contact details and bank details for payment purposes
 - All personal information that we obtain about you will be held, used and protected by us in accordance with the latest data protection law and this privacy policy.
 - We have procedures in place to ensure that our computer systems and databases are protected against unauthorised use, loss and damage. Should any breach be detected we shall inform those affected within 72 hours of discovery.
